Bootlegger's Run Hike (Upper Creve Coeur)

Starting Location: Upper Creve Coeur Park off Dorsett Rd. Continue on Streetcar Drive for 0.6 miles to gravel parking area on the right.

Description: A network of three loops exploring the forested hillsides of the Park overlooking Creve Coeur Lake on gently graded, packed earth paths. Distance: 4-6 miles.

Other: Dogs welcome but must be on leash. Bring water and snack to carry with you.

Directions:

- From I-270 Exit 17 for Dorsett Rd, go west 1.4 miles.
- Turn right into Creve Coeur Park on Streetcar Drive.
- Continue 0.6 miles to a gravel parking area on the right.
- The trail leaves from the southeast corner on this lot.

Forest Park CWE Hike

Description: We will explore the eastern end of the park on paved and gravel paths, then cross Kingshighway into the CWE to stroll the residential streets and the Euclid business area and if time permits, The Grove before returning to the park and the Visitors Center.

Distance: 3-4 miles.

Directions:

- We will meet at the Visitor Center (Dennis and Judith Jones Visitor and Education Center) (yellow building with clock tower) which is behind and to the east of the Missouri History Museum on Lindell Blvd. about halfway between Kingshighway Blvd. and Skinker Blvd.
- Park across from the Center. The address is 5595 Grand Drive.

Stops: Restrooms are available in the Visitor Center . Lunch in the CWE.

Starting Location: Quail Ridge Park, Wentzville, MO
560 Interstate Drive, Wentzville, MO 63385
Meeting at the Dog Park on Pawpaw Drive, Wentzville, Mo 63385

Description: This easy-moderate hike is on a paved trail loop for 2.9 miles with options for hiking loop again or hiking a variety of gravel trails. Will plan to hike approximately 5-6 miles total – with options for 2.9 -6 miles. Path mostly flat with some hills. Dogs welcome but must be on leash. Bathrooms at starting location.

Experience Level: EASY. A few gradual hills. Surface is both paved and mulched.

Directions:

Heading West on Highway 70:

- Take Exit 209 for Church Street toward Missouri Z,
- at the traffic circle take 3rd exit to State Highway Z for .3 miles,
- Turn left onto Interstate Drive .9 miles,
- Turn right on Quail Ridge Parkway (Park entrance) to right on PawPaw Dr. for .1 miles.
- At traffic circle & take 3rd exit to stay on PawPaw Dr to Quail Ridge Dog Park Parking Lot.

Heading North on Highway 64/40:

- Take exit 1C onto Prospect Road
- At the traffic circle take the 3rd exit to Prospect Road
- Turn right onto Interstate Road for 1.2 miles
- Turn left unto Quail Ridge Parkway (Park entrance) to right on Paw Paw Dr.
- At traffic circle take 3rd exit to PawPaw Drive to Quail Ridge Dog Park Parking Lot.

Other: Bring a snack and water. Restroom at start of hike.

Hike Leader:

Queeney Park HIKE (new start location on Mason Road)

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Starting Location: Queeney Recreational Complex **entrance off of Mason Road!!!**

Description: We will hike the park's well-marked trails through a variety of habitats: woodlands, grasslands. Some hills, gravel as well as dirt trails.

Directions:

- From intersection of 270 and Manchester, head west on Manchester to **Mason Road**.
- Turn right (north) on Mason Road or about 1 mile to Queeney Park.
- Turn left into park. Parking is immediately on your left.

Experience Level: EASY TO MODERATE 4 - 5 miles. Opportunities to shorten distance if needed. Some hills.

Stops: Occasional stops to regroup or take a snack break.

Other: Heated restrooms available near the parking lot. Dogs must be on leash. Bring snack, water bottle. Hiking boots or shoes and hiking poles are an option but nice to have on the hills.

Rockwoods Reservation HIKE

Description: Bundle up everybody and let's hike in Rockwoods. Leader plans to combine the Lime Kiln loop and Trail among the trees for at least 4.7 miles. Adding the Rock Quarry Trail would extend either 1 or 2 miles, depending upon loop and energy level.

Directions:

In Wildwood from Highway 100 take Highway 109 south for 2 miles, then Woods Avenue west 50 yards, and Glencoe Road north to Rockwoods. Park in lot near visitor center.

If approaching from I-44 in Eureka, take Highway 109 north, left on Woods Avenue 50 yards then right on Glencoe Road north to the visitor center on the left.

From Stacy we walk thru Olivette's shady neighborhoods including its paved bike trail looping back to Stacy Park.

Directions:

- From I-64 north on I-170
- Take Exit 3 for MO-340W.
- Left onto MO-340W/Olive Blvd. for 1.5 miles
- Left onto Old Bonhomme Rd.
- Right into Stacy Park.

Experience Level: AN EASY WALK. Mostly level, paved trail and/or sidewalks

Other: Bring water and snacks. Restrooms in park
